Note:

1. The Expert Committee considered the Compliance based on following :
 - a. Compliance of 4 aspect (Verification of Category-I Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) entitlement as notified by UGC, Permissibility of proposed programmes to be offered under ODL mode, Adherence to UGC Notification of Specification of Degrees, 2014 and its amendments and Prior approval of Regulatory Authority, wherever applicable)
 - b. Compliance of UGC (ODL Programme and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 as per affidavit submitted.
 - c. Compliance of deficiency Communicated.
 - d. Representation received by HEI against the earlier decision of 'Not found Complied.'
2. The HEI is entitled to offer the ODL programmes for the period, till they are Category-I HEIs as per the relevant UGC notifications /regulations and if not, they shall discontinue the programmes and accordingly, inform the same to UGC. The learners already enrolled in the current recognized programmes shall be allowed to complete the programmes in the laid down manner as per the University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 and its amendments.
3. Programmes under the purview of other regulatory authorities have been considered on the basis of NOC/ approval/ recommendation received from respective Regulatory Authority. The HEI shall abide by the conditions such as number of seats, valid academic year etc. mentioned in the relevant Regulatory Authority letter.
4. As per 578th Commission decision, Central or State or Private Universities don't require prior approval/recommendation/NOC from AICTE for offering of Undergraduate, Postgraduate and Postgraduate Diploma programmes falling under the discipline of Management, Computer Applications and Travel and Tourism. However, Deemed to be Universities are still required to seek prior approval/recommendation/ NOC of AICTE for offering of such programmes in ODL and/or Online mode.
5. Higher Education Institution shall write 'UGC entitled as per University Grants Commission (Categorization of Universities (only) for Grant of Graded Autonomy) Regulations, 2018 and its amendment(s)' instead of 'UGC recognized' at all places.

HEI shall offer the programmes found complied in Table above from the academic year 2024-25, academic session beginning October, 2024 (revised from July-August, 2024) and onwards.
