### How to reach Karaikudi?

**By Road:** Karaikudi is well connected with buses from neighbouring cities namely Madurai (80 km), Tiruchirappalli (100 km), Dindigul (100 km), Rameswaram (145 km). Distance between Karaikudi New Bus Stand and the University is 1.5 km.

**By Train:** There are daily express trains running from Chennai Egmore (MS) to Karaikudi (KKDI). In addition, daily passenger trains operate between Tiruchirappalli (TPJ) and Karaikudi. Distance between Karaikudi Junction and the University is 1 km.

**By Air:** Nearby airports are Madurai (IMX) and Tiruchirappalli (TRZ). It takes about 90 minutes from the airport to reach the University by car.

## Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE)

Directorate of Distance Education (DDE) was established in 1992.

Directorate of Online Programme (DOP) was established in 2018.

According to UGC (ODL & OL programme) Regulations 2020, both Open and Distance Learning (ODL) activities and Online Learning (OL) activities have been brought under one roof as the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE).

**Open and Distance Learning (ODL)** is a mode of providing flexible learning opportunities by overcoming separation of teacher and learner using a variety of media, including print, electronic, online and occasional interactive face-to-face meetings with the learners or Learner Support Services to deliver teaching-learning experiences, including practical or work experiences.

A Learner residing in any part of the country (India) may enroll in any programme being offered by a Higher Educational Institution recognised by the Commission provided that the Higher Educational Institution shall conduct all activities such as admissions, contact programmes, examinations etc. for learner strictly within the territorial jurisdiction of the Higher Educational Institution as specified in the regulation.

A University established or incorporated by or under a State Act shall offer programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and operate all other related activities (admission, PCP, examinations) only within the territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the territory of the state of its location.

**Online Learning (OL)** is a mode of providing flexible learning opportunities by overcoming separation of teacher and learner using internet, e-Learning Materials and full-fledged programme delivery through the internet using technology assisted mechanism and resources. There is no Territorial Jurisdiction norms, since all activities are done in online mode.

### [UGC Public Notice F.No.3-5/2022\(DEB-III\). Dt.02.09.2022](#)

University Grants Commission (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulations, 2020 stipulates **Equivalence of qualification acquired through Conventional or Open and Distance Learning and Online modes** that Degrees at under-graduate and post-graduate level in conformity with UGC notification on Specification of Degrees, 2014 and, post-graduate diplomas awarded through Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode by Higher Educational Institutions, recognised by the Commission under these regulations, shall be **treated as equivalent** to the corresponding awards of the Degrees at under-graduate and post-graduate level and post-graduate diplomas offered through conventional mode.

In general, the minimum eligibility / entry qualification for enrolling into UG/PG programme is as under;

## UGC - Distance Education Council (DEC) / Distance Education Bureau (DEB) Approval

### 1995-2009 : Ex-Post Facto Approval From DEC

The Distance Education Council (DEC), New Delhi has accorded ex-post facto approval for 108 programmes (order No.F.No.DEC/AU/KKD/TN/4425/2008, dated 24.11.2009) offered through the Distance mode of Alagappa University, Karaikudi, with effect from 1995 to the academic year were approved by the relevant authorities of the University as started by DEC.

The approval was given to the University based on the recommendation of the Expert Committee, the Distance Education Council, New Delhi.

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### 2010-2013 : Recognition from DEC

Consequent to the Inspection visit made by an Expert Team (Joint Action Committee) comprising of UGC-AICTE-DEC to the Alagappa University, the DEC has accorded recognition to various programmes offering through Distance mode vide F.No.DEC/Recog/2010/2289 dated 04.08.2010. Further this recognition was valid for a period of three years till Academic year 2012-13.

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### 2018 : Recognition / Entitlement from DEB

Alagappa University was accredited with A+ Grade by NAAC (CGPA : 3.64) in the Third Cycle & Graded as Category-I University by MHRD-UGC. By Virtue of holding Category-I status, the Distance Education programmes of Alagappa University has been recognized by UGC-DEB as per the Gazette notification F. No 1-8-2017(CPP-II) dated 12.02.2018 by the Government of India.

UGC Recognition Letter F.No. 74-2/2018 (DEB-I) November 2019-Updated the list of HEIs under Category-I as per UGC (categorisation of University (Only) for grant of Graded Autonomy) Regulation 2018 entitled to offer programmes through Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode and important information for stakeholders in supersession to this office letter of even number dated 26.03.2019. Out of 25 Universities listed eligible to offer ODL programme, Alagappa University is in the list (Serial Number 21).

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### 2023 - July 2023 session : Recognition / Entitlement from DEB

UGC-DEB Expert Committee made on-site visit to Alagappa University during 19-20 June 2023. Alagappa University has submitted Affidavit to UGC-DEB and ensured compliance to all 27 clauses/ provisions of the UGC (ODL programme & OL programme) Regulations 2020. The application of the Alagappa University was considered on receipt of Affidavit and other documents in compliance to the recommendation of the on-site visiting committee.

UGC-DEB has accorded Recognition / Entitlement to Alagappa University on 31.08.2023 to offer 17 PG programmes from academic session beginning July 2023 session and to offer 1 UG programme from February 2024 session (vide UGC Letter F.No.13-14/2023 (DEB II) dated 8<sup>th</sup> February, 2024).

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### 2024 - July 2024 session : Recognition / Entitlement from DEB

UGC-DEB has accorded Recognition / Entitlement to Alagappa University on September, 2024 to offer 1 PG & 7 UG programmes in ODL mode for the academic year 2024-25, academic session October, 2024 (revised from July – August, 2024) vide letter F.No.1-26/2024(DEB-1) dated September, 2024.

## ADMISSION

- ❖ A Learner residing in any part of the Country (India) may enroll in any ODL programme being offered by Alagappa University.
- ❖ Learner admission is done by ONLINE process fully managed by the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE), Alagappa University, Karaikudi.
- ❖ ABC id and DEB id are mandatory for getting admission in ODL/OL programmes.
- ❖ Programme delivery such as Personal Contact Programme (PCP) theory / practicals / project, assignment submission are being operated through the Head Quarters at Karaikudi and/or authorised Learner Support Centres (LSCs) within the state of Tamilnadu
- ❖ There are two sessions of admission every year; (i) August session and (ii) February session. UGC-DEB may extend the last date for admission from time to time.
- ❖ Learners can apply for admission by ONLINE process through Alagappa University web portal only.
- ❖ Alagappa University never engages franchising mode of admission. Hence, learners are informed to aware of this and NOT to entertain for admission through any third party / portal.
- ❖ Latest notifications will be made available to the public / prospective learners through University website. University will not pass admission related information to any third party. Hence, learners are advised NOT to listen to any third party / unauthorised person(s) information in social media (WhatsApp, YouTube etc.) about Alagappa University Distance Education admission, and such info may be treated as FAKE and NOT AUTHENTIC.
- ❖ Learners are informed to check for updates in the latest notification in CDOE webpage of the University from time to time.

## ADMISSION PROCEDURE

### **Cost of Application:**

- ❖ UG Degree / Diploma / Certificate programme: Rs.118/- (including GST).
- ❖ PG Degree programme: Rs.354/- (including GST).
- ❖ B.Ed. programme: Rs.590/- (including GST).
- ❖ The learners may seek admission either directly to the University (Head Quarters) or through any one of the approved Learner Support Centres (LSCs) within the state of Tamilnadu
- ❖ The list of approved Learner Support Centres is available in the University website.
- ❖ If a learner enroll directly with the University (Head Quarters), the Self Learning Materials (books) will be distributed directly to the learner and the Personal Contact Programme (PCP) classes will be arranged at Head Quarters (Alagappa University campus).
- ❖ If a learner enroll through any of the Learner Support Centre (LSC), the Self Learning Materials (books) will be given through the Learner Support Centre and the Personal Contact Programme (PCP) classes will be arranged by the Learner Support Centre where it is situated.

## ADMISSION BY ONLINE PROCESS

- ❖ The learners have to register and login the University webportal. Following documents are to be attached along with the application ONLINE:
- ❖ Entry qualification of H.Sc. / Diploma / Degree / Provisional Certificate and other required documents.
- ❖ Online payment for the prescribed programme fee along with cost of Application, ICT Fee. Refer to Annexure-1 for fee details.
- ❖ The Centre for Distance and Online Education will issue Transfer Certificate on production of original Transfer Certificate of previous study. However, a 'Course Completion Certificate' may be issued for those candidates who apply for it with prescribed fee.
- ❖ Please note that no other fee except Programme Fee and Examination Fee is payable by the learner to the Learner Support Centre. The learners are advised not to pay any fee in the form of cash to the

Learner Support Centre under any circumstances. Further, learners are informed to refer the prospectus for payment of actual Programme Fee.

### **ADMISSION CONFIRMATION**

- ❖ After scrutinizing the documents, the Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) shall confirm Admission to the eligible candidates and assign Enrolment Number. The Identity card will be downloaded through portal. Learners are instructed to keep the Identity Card in safe custody till they complete the programme. Once the learner is admitted, his/her registration is valid for the entire period of the study, subject to the payment of programme fee for the respective years.
- ❖ Before submitting the application ONLINE, the learners should ensure their eligibility for admission to the programme for which they apply.
- ❖ No learner should register for two programmes in the CDOE in the same year. The University reserves the right not to conduct any of the programmes if the circumstances so warrant. If the certificate submitted by the learner is in any language other than English / Tamil, an English version of the certificate, duly attested by a Gazetted Officer should be attached, failing which such certificate will not be considered. In case of certificates / Degree of Indian / Foreign Educational Institution, such Institutions must be Members of Association of Indian Universities or Commonwealth Universities. The CDOE reserves the right to revise, modify, add or delete any part of the syllabus, considering the welfare of the learners.
- ❖ There will not be any separate communication / reminder to the learner from the CDOE for payment of second/ third year programme fee. The second / third year fee is to be paid whether the learner has taken up the examinations or not / results declared or not.
- ❖ If the learners have any programme fee dues in second / third years, they will not be permitted to attend the examination.

### **TUITION FEE**

- ❖ Minimum study period is 3 years for UG programme and 2 years for PG programme.
- ❖ Maximum study period allowed for completion is DOUBLE the minimum study period (6 years for UG and 4 years for PG).
- ❖ 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Year learners are informed to remit the tuition fee (without fine) on or before 30<sup>th</sup> September (those admitted in July session) and on or before 30<sup>th</sup> March (those admitted in January session). Fine of Rs.500 will be charged on remittance of tuition fee after the due date mentioned (during minimum study period). Additional fine of Rs.1000 per year will be charged on remittance of tuition fee after the minimum study period, but before the maximum study period allowed.
- ❖ Learners having pending tuition fee will not be allowed to sit for the examination.
- ❖ If the learners do not remit the required tuition fee within the maximum study period, then they will be treated as discontinued and will not be allowed to sit for the examination.

### **LEARNER SUPPORT CENTRE (LSC)**

- ❖ LSC is established in a college or institution affiliated to a University or in a Govt. recognised HEI offering programmes in the same broad areas having the necessary infrastructure and human resources for offering the programme
- ❖ LSC shall be the contact point managed by HEI for providing academic as well as administrative support to its learners.
- ❖ LSC shall be headed by a Coordinator who shall be a regular teacher not below the rank of a qualified Assistant Professor of the concerned College or HEI and assisted by the counsellors as decided by the HEI.

### **TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION**

- A University established or incorporated by or under a State Act shall offer programmes in

Open and Distance Learning (ODL) mode and operate all other related activities only within the territorial jurisdiction allotted to it under its Act and in no case beyond the territory of the state of its location.

### **SELF LEARNING MATERIALS (SLM)**

- ❖ Hard copies of Self Learning Materials (SLMs) will be dispatched to learners who have remitted the required programme tuition fee.
- ❖ Soft copies of SLMs have been uploaded and available on the University website.

### **ASSIGNMENT**

- ❖ Learners should submit two assignments per course of credit 4.
- ❖ Assignment submission due date is 30<sup>th</sup> November / 31<sup>st</sup> March in a year as the case may be.
- ❖ End semester Examination results will be withheld for learners who have not submitted the assignments.

### **PERSONAL CONTACT PROGRAMME (PCP)**

- ❖ PCP for Science-Lab based programmes will be conducted at Head Quarters (Karaikudi) only.
- ❖ PCP will be conducted during October / November (for those admitted in July session) at the Head Quarters and/or authorized LSCs.
- ❖ PCP will be conducted during March / April (for those admitted in January session) at the Head Quarters and/or authorized LSCs.
- ❖ Learners are informed to check for updates in the latest notification in webpage from time to time.

### **EXAMINATION**

- ❖ The evaluation shall include two types of assessments; (i) continuous or formative assessment in the form of Assignment and PCP; (ii) summative assessment in the form of end semester examination.
- ❖ The learner should submit two assignments per course of credit 4 and have minimum attendance of 75% in the programme for specific PCP.
- ❖ End semester Examination will be conducted twice a year: (i) last week of December and (ii) first week of May.
- ❖ Learners are informed to check for updates in the latest notification in webpage from time to time.
- ❖ Statement of Marks, Provisional Certificate, Degree / Diploma Certificates shall be sent to the candidates by the Controller of Examinations directly to the learners.

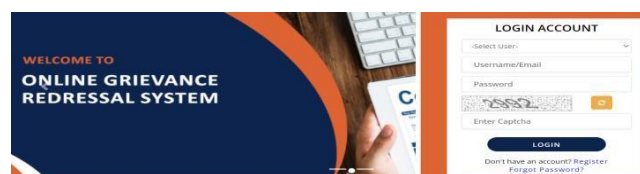
